

Hall of Fame Started for Women Who Make Aviation Achievements

NEW YORK, July 19. (AP)—Women who create new records will be recorded in a hall of fame of their own.

Lady Mary Heath, president of the Women's International Aeronautical Association, announced here that the Federation Aeronautique Internationale has authorized the creation of "a new category of feminine records."

Women's records will not be controlled in each country by the men; representatives of the federation, an idea which has long been approved by the National Aeronautic association in America.

Record holders in this new category are announced as follows:

Endurance—Eleanor Smith, America, 26 hours odd; runner up, Marie Beale, France 2 hours odd.

Altitude—Phoebe Fairgrave Omlie, America, 25,900 feet; runner up, Marge Crossen, America, 22,000 feet.

Seaplane altitude—Lady Heath, Great Britain, 13,000 feet.

Speed—Louise M. Thaden, America, 166 miles per hour.

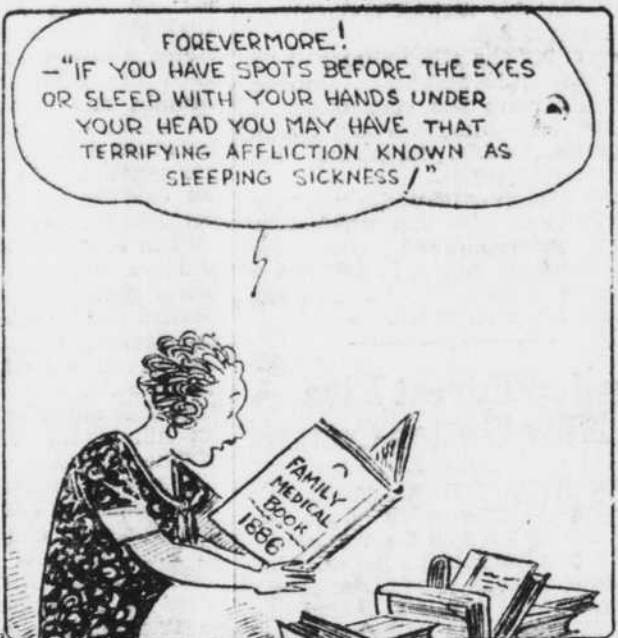

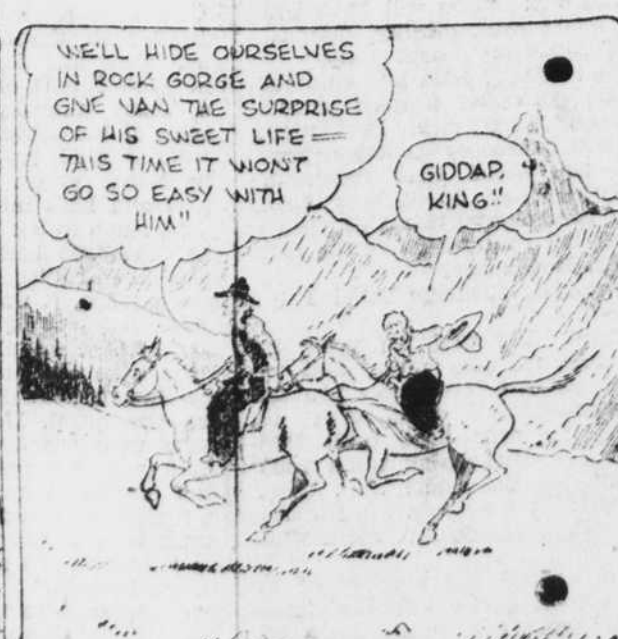
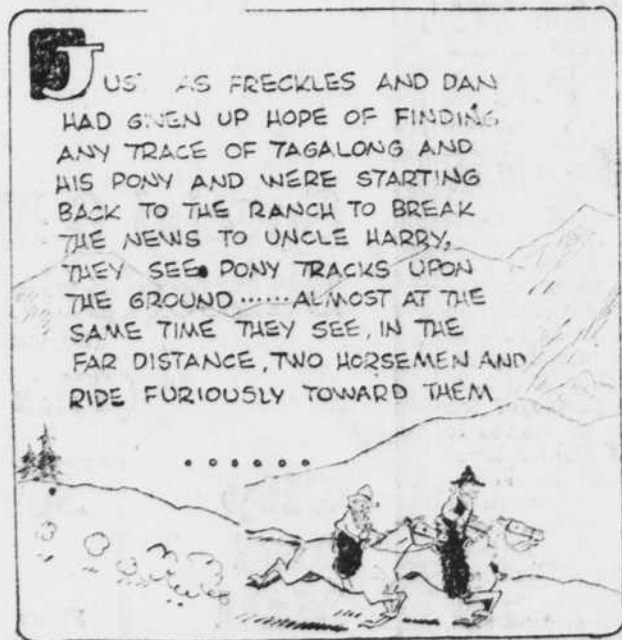
