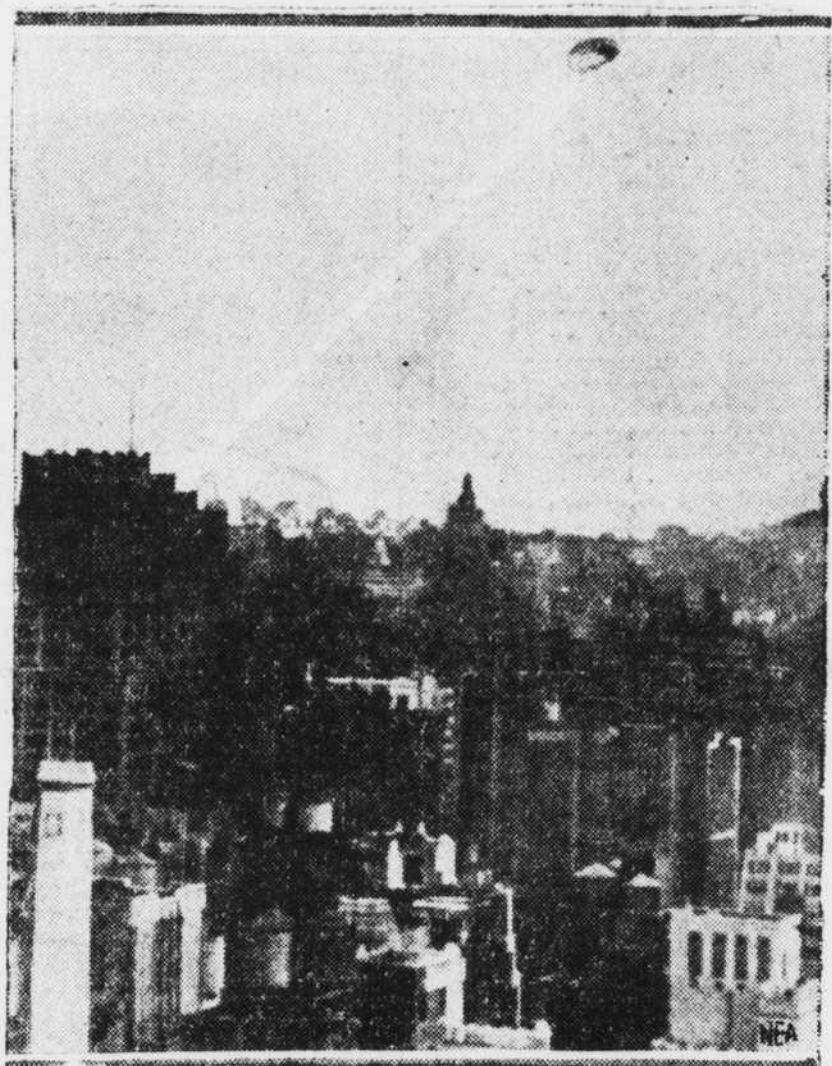

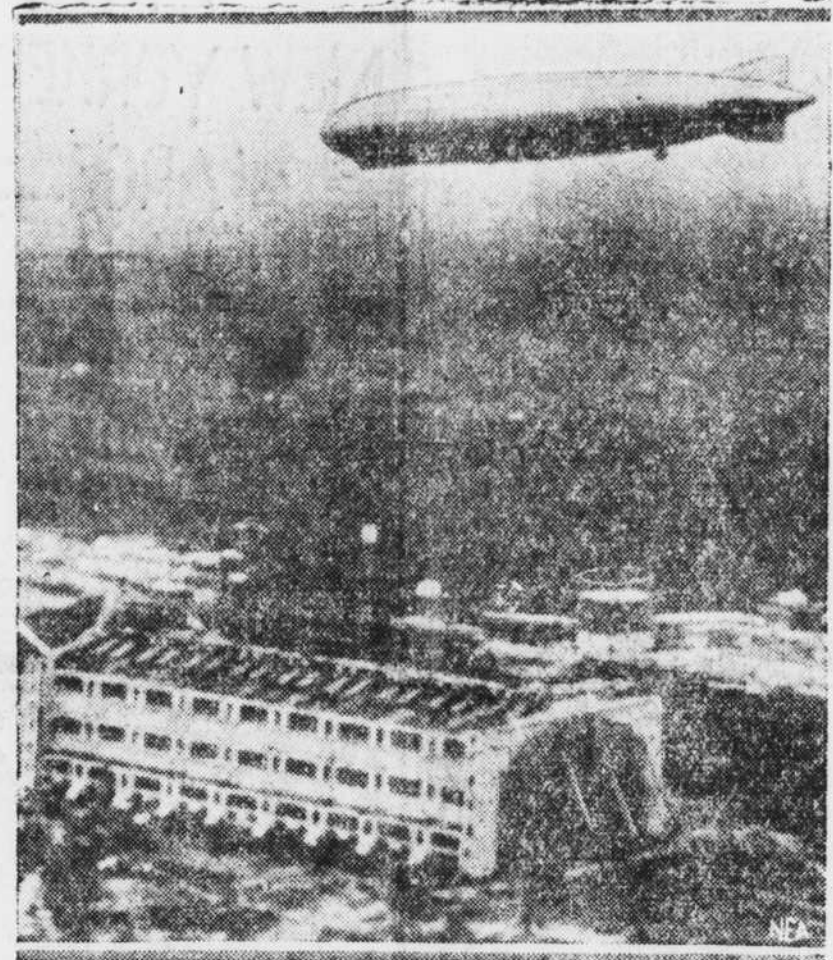

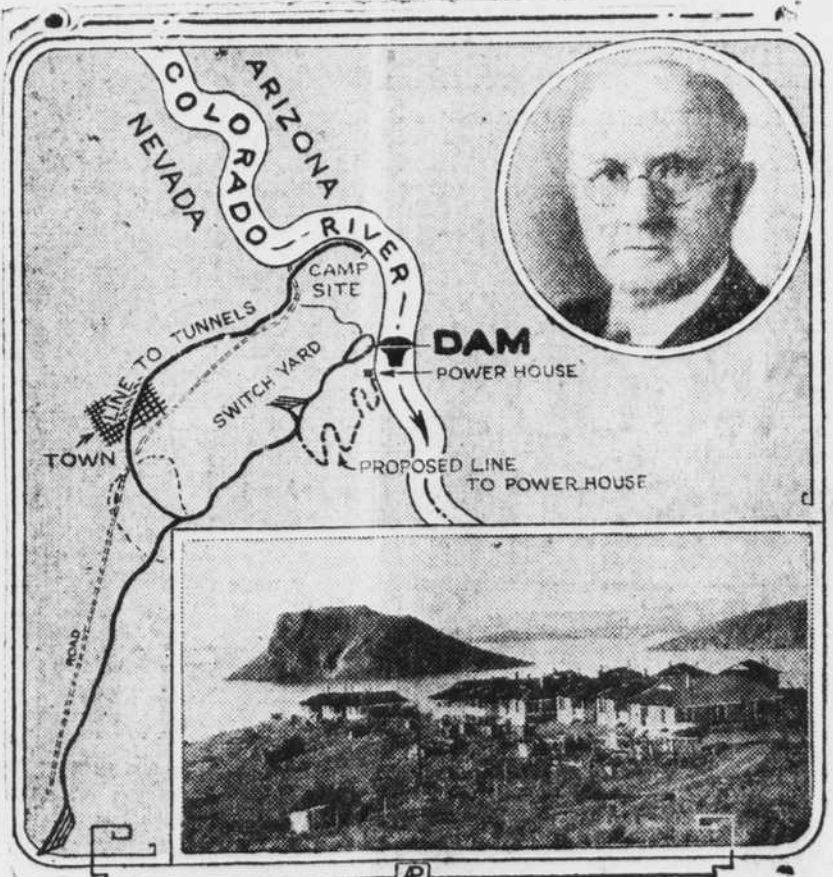


This telephoto, transmitted from New York to San Francisco, shows the giant Graf Zeppelin moving over New York's Broadway from the Battery...
