A six-home court is being built for E. A. Ferron at Third and Alford courts, in Boulder Addition, by the Las Vegas Construction Company, Inc. Several buildings are being moved to the ground under direction of Walter J. Alford of the company. These will be demolished and new structures built for the remainder of the court. Four of the buildings will be constructed now. Each home will have a living room, bedroom, bath and kitchen, and will be equipped in modern fashion. The work will take about a month and a half, according to Alford.

Five U. P. Engines to Have Larger Tanks

Five new 18000 gallon tanks will be installed in the locomotive shops operated on the Union Pacific between Caliente and Reno, according to Frank Cory, car foreman. These new tanks, which will supplant the present 12000 gallon tanks, are 200 in the yards and are being prepared for installation in the immediate future. Several water spouts on the rim will have to be added before the new tanks can be used, according to Cory, for the new tanks will rise 100 high in the air for use of some of the present spouts. These tanks will be installed in the 2500 class engines.

CORN FONDUE A TASTY DISH

Breakfast: Ready Cooked Corn Cakes, Cream Muffins, Coffee

LUNCHEON: Cucumbers and Tomato Sandwiches, Tea

DINNER: Corn Fondue, Buttered Green Beans, Bread, Peach Jam

Head Lettuce, French Dressing, Blueberry Pudding, Lemon Sauce, Coffee

Quickly Made Sugar Cookies

2-3 cup fat

1-2 cups sugar

2 eggs

1 teaspoon nutmeg

1 teaspoon vanilla

1-4 teaspoon salt

4 tablespoons cream

3-2 cups flour

2 teaspoons baking powder

Cream the fat and sugar. Add the rest of the ingredients and drop portions from the end of a spoon onto greased baking sheets. Bake in a moderate oven for 12 minutes.

Corn Fondue, Serving Six

1 cup soft bread crumbs

1 cup milk

1 tablespoon chopped onions

2 tablespoons chopped green peppers (these can be omitted)

2 cups corn, cut from cob

3 egg yolks, cut from egg

1-2 cup cheese, cut fine

3 egg whites, stiffly beaten

2 tablespoons butter, melted

Mix the bread and milk. Add the rest of the ingredients and pour into a buttered baking dish. Bake in a slow oven for 35 minutes.

Blueberry Pudding

2 cups flour

2 teaspoons baking powder

1-4 teaspoon salt

1 cup sugar

1 teaspoon vanilla

1 egg

3-3 cup milk

1-2 cups blueberries

1 teaspoon nutmeg

5 tablespoons fat, melted

Mix the ingredients and pour into a greased shallow pan. Bake in a moderate oven for 25 minutes.
