Dirigible Base Funds Sought

SAN FRANCISCO, Oct. 16. (UP)—Business leaders of four counties today strove to raise money with which to present the Sunnyvale dirigible base site to the government free.

The choice of the navy dirigible base on the Pacific coast has narrowed down to the San Diego and Sunnyvale locations. San Diego has offered its site free.
All things being equal the navy will recommend the Sunnyvale site to congress, information from Washington said.

In an attempt to secure the base for the San Francisco bay region business leaders of Santa Clara, San Mateo, Alameda and San Francisco counties are attempting to raise \$230,000 so that the Sunnyvale site can be purchased and offered to the government free.

Santa Clara county has already pledged \$190,000 of the purchase price, which is \$339,000. The site is 1,000 acres in area.
