

Plainsmen Acquit College Head Accused of Killing Son-in-Law

WEATHERFORD, Tex., Nov. 6 (AP)—R. H. Hamilton, former appellate court judge and president of Howard Payne college, charged with murder in connection with the slaying of his son-in-law, Tom Walton, Jr., was found not guilty here tonight by a jury of eleven Texas plainsmen and a local bank cashier.

Foreclosure Is Filed Against Las Vegas Development Co.

A \$39,846.22 mortgage foreclosure was filed Tuesday against the Las Vegas Development company by J. A. Bailey and Nan H. Bailey. In default of payment on a \$40,570 note, for which lands including parts of Boulder Dam Park and "Boulder Dam City" were listed as securities, it is alleged the \$39,846.22 became due, according to terms of the contract.

The corporation, according to the contract, a copy of which was appended to the complaint, promised to pay Mr. and Mrs. Bailey that amount for value received "as joint tenants with a right of survivorship and not as tenants in common or order."

\$1810 on interest and \$720.78 on principal were paid, and no more, according to the complaint, which was filed by McNamee and McNamee.
