ORDINANCE NO. 148

An Ordinance empowering, authorizing and directing the ex-officio Assessor of the City of Las Vegas, County of Clark, State of Nevada, to levy a special assessment to defray the costs of making certain improvements in the City of Las Vegas...

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas Do Ordain: Section 1. For the purpose of defraying the costs of making certain improvements in the City of Las Vegas, by constructing, erecting and installing an ornamental street lighting system complete, including conduits, cables, standards, lighting units and all appurtenances thereon...

Section 2. The ex-officio City Assessor shall assess the taxable lots, property and premises situated in the special assessment district created by the terms of said Ordinance No. 142, benefited by said improvements proportionately to the benefits received...

Section 3. In levying the assessments as in this Ordinance provided, the ex-officio Assessor shall prepare a Special Assessment Roll therefor, and after he shall have completed the Assessment as herein provided and completed the Special Assessment Roll, he shall refer the same to the Board of City Commissioners as provided for by law...
