Police Continue War Against Rabies Scourge

Anyone Bitten By Dog Is Advised to Consult Physician Immediately; Many Dogs Are Killed.

More than twenty dogs suffering with rabies have been killed in the last few days by city police...

Most of these were killed at request of the owners. It was said, many of them having called up police headquarters to report that their dogs were behaving strangely.

Another dog's head, and a cat's head, were sent Tuesday to Carson City for analysis to determine definitely whether it was rabies from which the animal had suffered.

Ten dogs and a cat were killed Tuesday and more yesterday. The only way a human being can be saved from rabies, once infected with the dread disease, is by prompt action in the taking of an anti-rabies virus treatment, according to Nash.

There are several of these, and their application calls for a succession of inoculations, daily for at least fourteen days. The virus must be used within three days of the time it is made. It is stated, and the most convenient places to secure the substance for use in Las Vegas are Los Angeles and San Francisco.

In man 57 to 80 days comprises the average period of incubation, while in dogs it is three to four weeks and in cats two to four weeks. In children the time is reduced about one-third.

Cooperation of every citizen in keeping down the epidemic is asked by police. Besides reporting any dog which might be a victim of the disease to police, it is asked that all dogs be kept tied or confined.

By STEWART BROWN (United Press Staff Correspondent) PARIS, Dec. 4.—A labor market, where farm hands are auctioned off to the highest bidder, still exists in France.

Unlike the slave markets of old, French farm laborers willingly take part in the annual auctions. There is nothing inhuman or forced in their sale of their own bodies for a stated period of toil for they get the sale money minus a fee for the auctioneer.

As witnessed at the annual "Foire aux Valets," or Workmen's Fair, at Chateaufort, the farm hands consider it a banner day of the year because it brings new employers, new surprises — and often more money.
