ORDINANCE NO. 165 AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT GAMING AND OPERATION OF OBTAINING A LICENSE THERE- any FOR, REGULATING THE SAME and FIXING THE AMOUNT OF SUCE. LICENSE, PROVIDING A PEN-ALTY THEREFOR, REFEALING ORDINANCES Nos: 77, 82, 88, 103. and 115, and ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN

CONFLICT THEREWITH. The Board of Commissioners of City of Las Vegas Do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful corporation, ci her as owner lessee, or employee, whether for hire or not, to deal, operate, carry on, conduct, maintain, or expose for play, within the City of Las Vegas, any game of faro, monte roulette, kend, fan-tan, twenty-one stud poker, draw poker, or any banking or percentage game played with cards, dice, or any mechanical device or machine, for money property, checks, credit, or any representative of value; or any gambling game in which any person, firm, association or corporation keeping, conducting, managing, permitting the same to be carried on, receives, directly or indirectly, any compensation or reward or any percentage or share of the money or property played, for keeping, running, carrying on or permitting the said gam's to be carried on; or to play, maintain, or keep any slot machine played for money, for checks or tokens redeamable in money or property without having first procured a license for the same as hereinafter provided; and provided further. that no alien, or any person ex-cep a citizen of the United States, shall be issued a license, or shall directly or indirectly own, operate or control any game or device so brensed.

Section 2. It shall be unlawfu! for any person, firm, association or corporation to knowingly permit any ci the slot machines games or devices mentioned ir section one of this Ordinance to conducted, opera'ed, dealt carried on in any house or building owned by him, her or it, ir whole or in part, except by a person, firm, association or corporaherein provided or his employee. Section 3. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the term game or games shall be construed to mean and include all games or devices nergin mentioned and any slc" machine or slot machines played ney or for checks or token


