Singing For Partner, Ill in Hospital, Girl's "Blues" Win Riches For Both

NEW YORK. (AP)—Ethel Merman, Crazy, in her peculiar "blues" voice, shouts a song about the indiscretions of Delilah and the audience applauds an enchanting new entertainer. One night she is unknown—the next night crowds are fighting to get into the theater to hear her sing. Ethel Merman isn't singing only for herself; she's singing for a young pianist who lies dangerously ill in a Connecticut hospital.

Al Siegel played his last performance the night his partner achieved her great triumph; then he collapsed. Only a couple of years ago Miss Merman was a stenographer in Long Island City. Siegel was a recognized vaudeville artist, and one night he heard her sing at a party. He persuaded her to become his partner, trained her and wrote songs that were fitted to her unusual voice. They appeared in a few picture houses, and then were offered parts in the musical comedy, "Girl

During rehearsal Siegel, who was in frail health, collapsed and was put to bed. On the opening night in New York he demanded that he be allowed to play for Miss Merman when she made her debut. Doctors, fearing a nervous relapse, placed him in an ambulance and carried him to the theater. Siegel was carried to the piano in the orchestra pit and thrilling were his playing and Miss Merman's singing that the audience stood cheering and stopped the show.

Miss Merman began to sing an encore, but stopped as her piano accompaniment did not begin. She looked into the pit and saw that Siegel had fallen in a faint across the keys.

Today it is still Siegel and Merman, partners. From his hospital bed he writes songs for her. In New York she sings them, along with Gerushwa numbers, in her show and in night clubs. And each week half of the salary goes to him.
