MERRIMACK, Wis., May 27 (UP)—Capturing rattlesnakes alive was Elmer Kettel's hobby when he was a boy; now it is a profitable business for him every spring.
Every April and May for twenty years he has hunted rattlesnakes, bull snakes, blue racers, and spotted adders in the granite bluffs on his farm near Devil's lake state park. He sells live snakes to carnivals, circuses, zoological museums and laboratories and tanned skins to leather manufacturers who use them for women's shoes and purses. He also finds a market for rattlesnake venom, used to make an antitoxin serum.

NEW MOTORS FASTER IN 1931 AUTO CLASSIC

INDIANAPOLIS, May 27 (UP)—Courage and skill of drivers in the annual 500-mile automobile race at the Indianapolis motor speedway May 30 may be challenged as never before in the spectacular history of the event.

New rules permitting additional valves and carburetors virtually open the way to speed maximums never before attained on the rough bricks of the four-cornered two and one-half mile track. Improved spring suspension, greater freedom from tire hazards, and other mechanical betterments will put the distinction of speed solely up to the pilot of practically every one of the forty cars which will be permitted to start.
