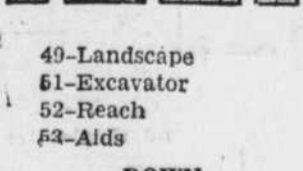

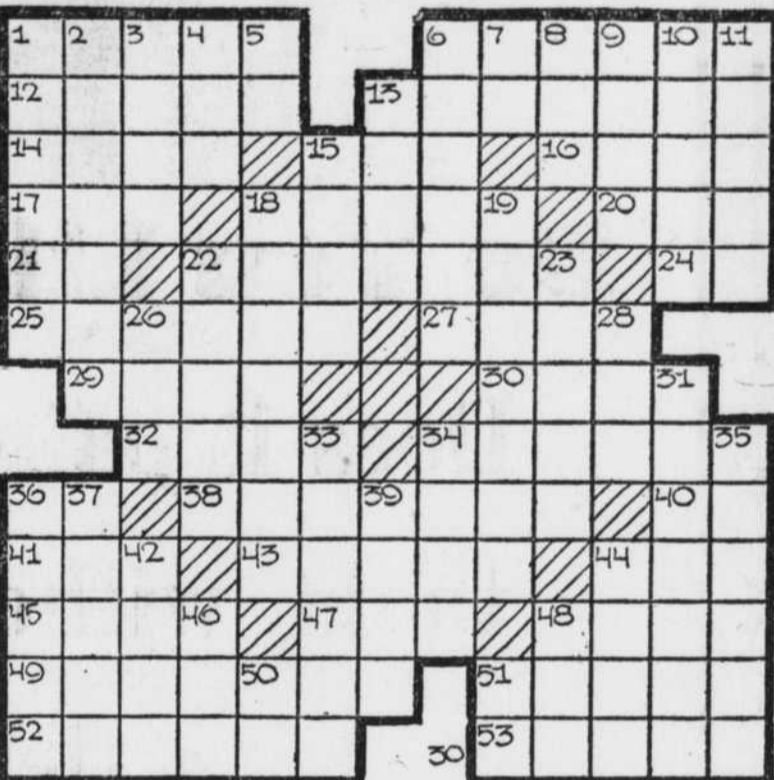

ACCIDENT LAUNCHES AIRPLANE MANUFACTURER ON HIS CAREER

SEATTLE, Dec. 26. (UP)—Sometimes little, almost unnoticed things change careers and lead to success!

Consider W. E. Boeing, who came here in 1916 from Detroit, to go into the lumber business. He took up flying as a sport. He had an accident and tinkered with the plane in a little shop on Lake Union.

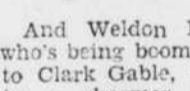
The work fascinated him. So he decided to build a plane, and employed three men. The war was on and the United States soon entered it. The government thought so much of the plane that it gave him a contract. Thus was born the Boeing Airplane company, now one of the largest industries in the Pacific Northwest and one of the largest airplane factories in the world. It employs 1,100 men and is working at capacity. About three and a half million dollars in army and navy plane contracts will keep the plant going at capacity until April or May, with every hope of securing additional government and commercial contracts in the meantime.
