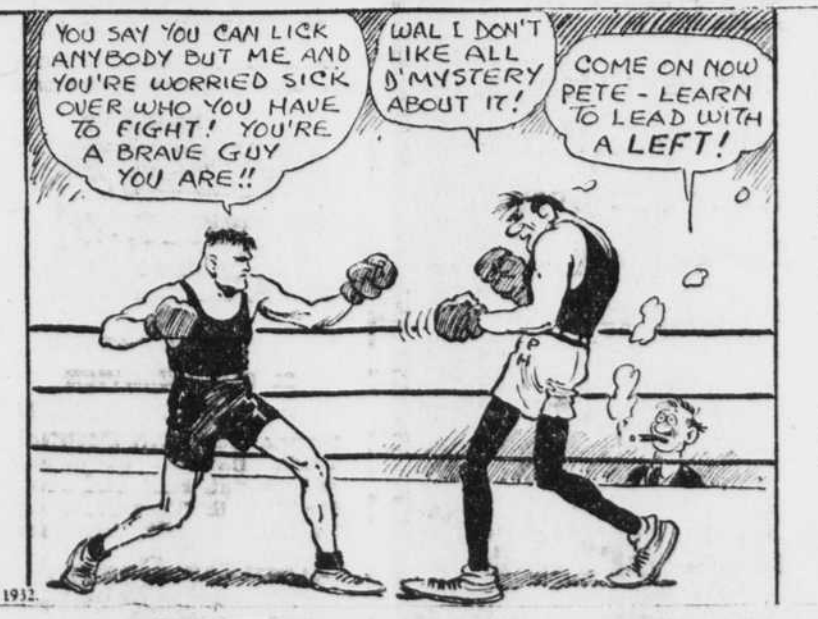
Father Time Shows Hand in Chicago Match
