By RICHARD L. GRIDLEY (United Press Financial Writer) NEW YORK, Mar. 14. (U.P.)—News of Ivar Kreuger, whose financial interests penetrate almost every financial center of the world caused a wave of selling in his companies today and dragged prices downward in various security markets.

Early support in stocks was attributed to the good impression in financial circles to the heavy plurality polled by President Von Hindenburg in the German election, a development that many traders believed would aid in stabilization of German economic affairs.

Several new developments hastened the decline in the general market in the late trading, selling at one interval forcing the tape three minutes behind trading on the floor.
