SENATE Passed a tariff bill substituted for the one sent from the house.

Chairman Reed Smoot of the finance committee announced hearings would open next week on the billion dollar tax bill passed by the house today.

Senator Lewis, Dem., Ill., proposed an investigation into the possibility of consolidating five major government departments.

Senator Sheppard, Dem., Tex., announced a judiciary sub-committee Tuesday would begin hearings on three of his bills designed to clarify the Volstead act.

Passed the billion dollar tax bill by a vote of 327 to 84.

The death of Rep. Albert Vestal, Repn., Ind., was announced.

Chairman Jones of the agriculture committee introduced a bill directing the department of agriculture spend a portion of funds already appropriated for research into possible new markets for cotton and other farm products.
