'SOVIET ENEMIES' DOOMED TO DEATH

MOSCOW, Wednesday, April 6 (UP)—Judas Stern and Sergel Vassiloff were sentenced to death today for shooting the German embassy counselor, Dr. Fritz Von Twardowski, in a terrorist plot designed to involve Soviet Russia in difficulties with European nations. The death sentence for the two alleged anti-Soviet terrorists was demanded by Prosecutor Nicholas Krilenko in a dramatic midnight session of the trial.
