ORDINANCE No. 186

An Ordinance to prohibit the sale or keeping for sale of fireworks in the City of Las Vegas, and pres-cribing a punishment therefor. The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain as

Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firm, company, corporation or association, within the City of Las Vegas, to keep for sale at retail or to sell at retail any rocket, squib, firecracker, Roman candle, torpedo or other fireworks or substance designed or intended for pyrotechnic display.

Sec. 2. Any person or persons, firm, company, corporation or association who or which shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not dess than five or more than fifty days, or by hoth such fine and imprisonment.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon and after its passage and publication one work (6 issues) in Las Vegas Age, a daily newspaper published in said City of Las Vegas 1. It shall be unlawful for
