

TERMINAL SHOPS DRAW W. B. C. BUYERS

Now completely occupied, Boulder City's new Terminal building houses nine business and professional enterprises.

Proving one of the most active shopping centers of the thriving reservation city, these shops and offices in the modern structure offer to the residents of Boulder City service in varied lines.

The big triangular building, edged by a cool and shady arcade to protect promenading shoppers from the hot desert sun, fronts on two of the city's leading thoroughfares.

F. W. Gottwals, designer and

owner of the building, operates a taxi business, using Cadillac cars for business and sightseeing trips to all points of interest in and around Boulder City. In connection with the taxi, Gottwals also operates a freight storage depot and transfer line. With new and modern equipment and efficient drivers the Gottwals' taxi, transfer and storage business is a credit to Boulder City.

Miller's cafe, one of the finest in the city, occupies the large, airy and well ventilated room at the upper end of the building.

Strictly modern in every respect, this cafe, although opening its doors for business only two days ago, has already served hundreds of transient and local residents, many of whom are here in their praise of the good food, quick service and pleasant atmosphere which prevails. Soda fountain service as well as cigars, tobaccos and confections are offered to patrons.

Mr. Miller, an experienced restaurant man, takes pride in the culinary department of his cafe. His kitchen, he says, will be kept immaculate and is open for inspection at all times.

Boulder City's store for men, owned by Bill Harrison and operated by himself and J. W. Stone, occupies the room adjoining the cafe. "Bill" and "Stoney" have made a host of friends in the short time they have been in Boulder City, which is evidenced by the large amount of business they are doing.

Society Diana clothes, Clinton shoes and Wilson Brothers' furnishings are among the popular brands of merchandise offered.

Next to the Bill Harrison store is located the office of Dastrop, the Insurance Man. Protection is the watchword in this office and Das-

trop has a policy for every need.

Five master barbers make up the personnel of the Terminal Barber shop. They are O. E. Rhodes and J. M. Higgins, proprietors, and O. R. Packard, F. C. Nelson and R. E. Doe.

The shop which is artistically decorated in black and white is equipped with modern, electric appliances. Special attention is given to ladies and children.

The true atmosphere of the desert is typified by the Nava-Hopi Indian store, managed by Sam M. Richardson. The largest stock of genuine Indian-made goods in the

state of Nevada is on display here. Hundreds of Navajo rugs in as many different designs and patterns, Hopi-made pottery and a large collection of Navajo jewelry complete the stock.

A circulating library containing more than 500 volumes is also maintained in the Indian store.

H. C. Tebbs and son, C. F. Tebbs, maintain an insurance office in the Terminal bus station. They are state agents for the Occidental Life Insurance company.

O. G. Olson is the special Boulder City agent representing the Tebbs agency.

Numbered among the first in Boulder City was Dr. Wheelwright, dentist, who came from Payson, Utah, where he practiced dentistry for ten years. Associated with Dr. Wheelwright is Dr. Hutchings, who also has a record of practicing ten years in St. George, Utah. Wheelwright and Hutchings were classmates, having both been graduated from the University of Denver, college of dentistry.
