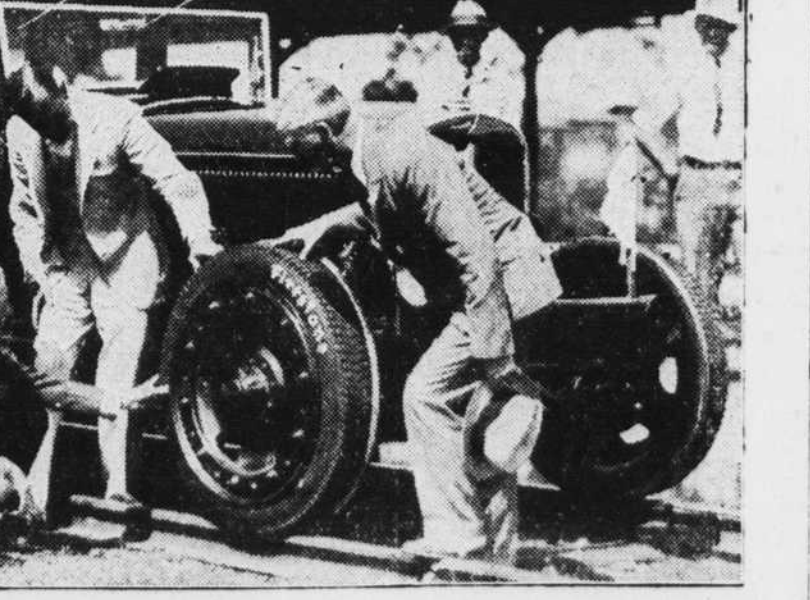
WORK RUSHED ON GREEN HUT CAFE
