DEMISEY IGNORED The candidacy of Jack Demsey, former heavyweight champion of the world for membership on the national convention delegation was scarcely considered. His name was ignored by the nominating committee. Later when nominated from the floor, heavy laughter from upstate delegates prevented a vote.

John Madison Gray, secretary of the state central committee opposed Demsey's selection, contending that Nevada was filled with Republicans more deserving of the honor. The prohibition question was not brought up in the meeting.

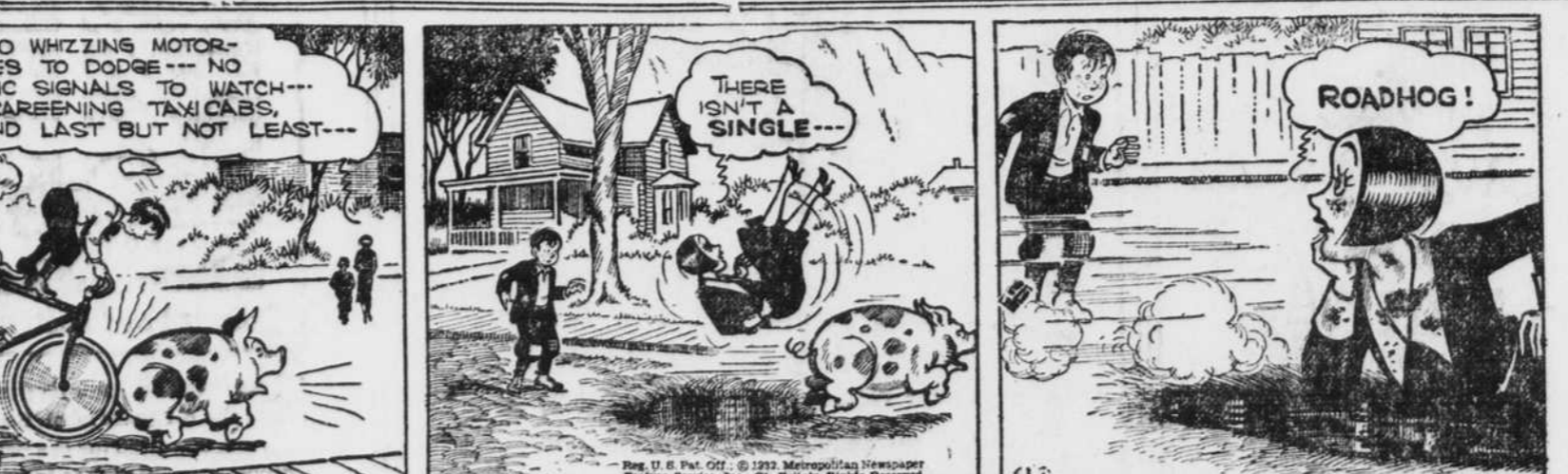
