SENATE
Voted in three minutes to approve proposed changes in Hawaiian laws to prevent a second hung jury from freeing persons alleged to have attacked Mrs. Thalia Masie.
Senator Hale, Repn., Me., sought consideration of a bill authorizing construction of the navy to the London and Washington treaty limits.
Judiciary committee recommended to sub-committee the nomination of Judge James H. Wilkerson to the circuit bench in Chicago. Finance committee continued.

Senator Shortridge, Repn., Calif., appeared before immigration committee in support of a measure to bar Filipino laborers from entry in the United States.
HOUSE
Bonus bill was condemned before house ways and means committee as a threat to the gold standard by John Janney of New York, chairman of the board of the American Society of Practical Economists.
Agriculture committee favorably reported a bill appropriating \$1,000,000 to fight a threatened grasshopper plague in western states.
Speaker Garner served notice on the senate that the house leadership would not accept hastily considered reduction in government appropriation bills.
Rep. Crisp, Dem., Ga., introduced a bill which would provide a congressional pardon for the four Americans convicted in the Hawaiian "honor slaying."
