Dr. Karl W. Niemann, veterinarian associated with the state livestock commission, arrived in Las Vegas Tuesday and will devote his time in this community to regulatory work in connection with the state board of stock commissioners and private practice.

A graduate of Kansas State Agricultural college, Niemann has established an enviable reputation for himself in the northern section of Nevada. Well known to stockmen of that part of the state, he has done work in connection with the livestock commission for the last three years.

Niemann, who has just finished his term as president of the state veterinary association, has been connected with the University of Nevada experiment station in Reno. Prior to his practice in Nevada, he served several years with the bacteriology and pathology departments of the Kansas State Agricultural

BURIED ALIVE, WILL RECOVER

E. Pate, operator of the ditching machine being used on the sewer excavation work on north Fifteenth street, had a narrow escape from serious injury yesterday morning when a pile of timbers and dirt fell upon him as he was working in the sewer ditch.

Pate was placed in the newly excavated portion of the ditch which was cut through soft, water-soaked soil, necessitating the lining of the walls to prevent a cave-in, when the accident occurred.

Workmen who were nearby released him from the debris and took him to the Las Vegas hospital, where an examination revealed that he had suffered a broken collar bone and body bruises.

While in Las Vegas, he plans to specialize in small animal diseases. His offices will be in the farm bureau quarters at 126 north Second street.

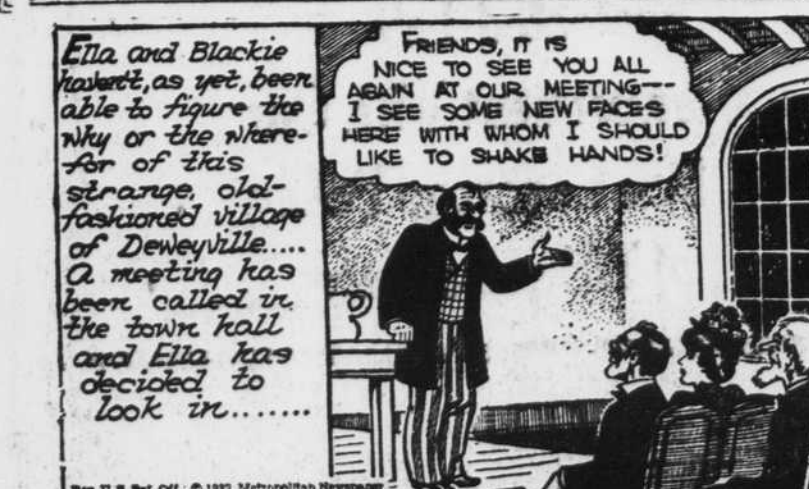

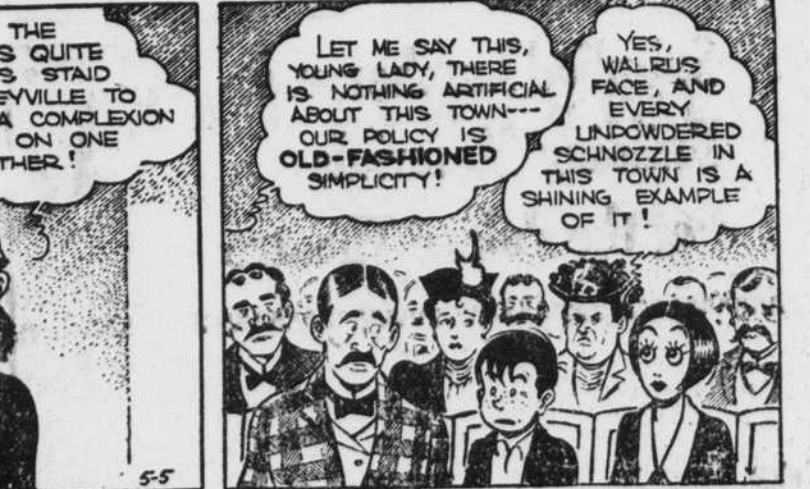
