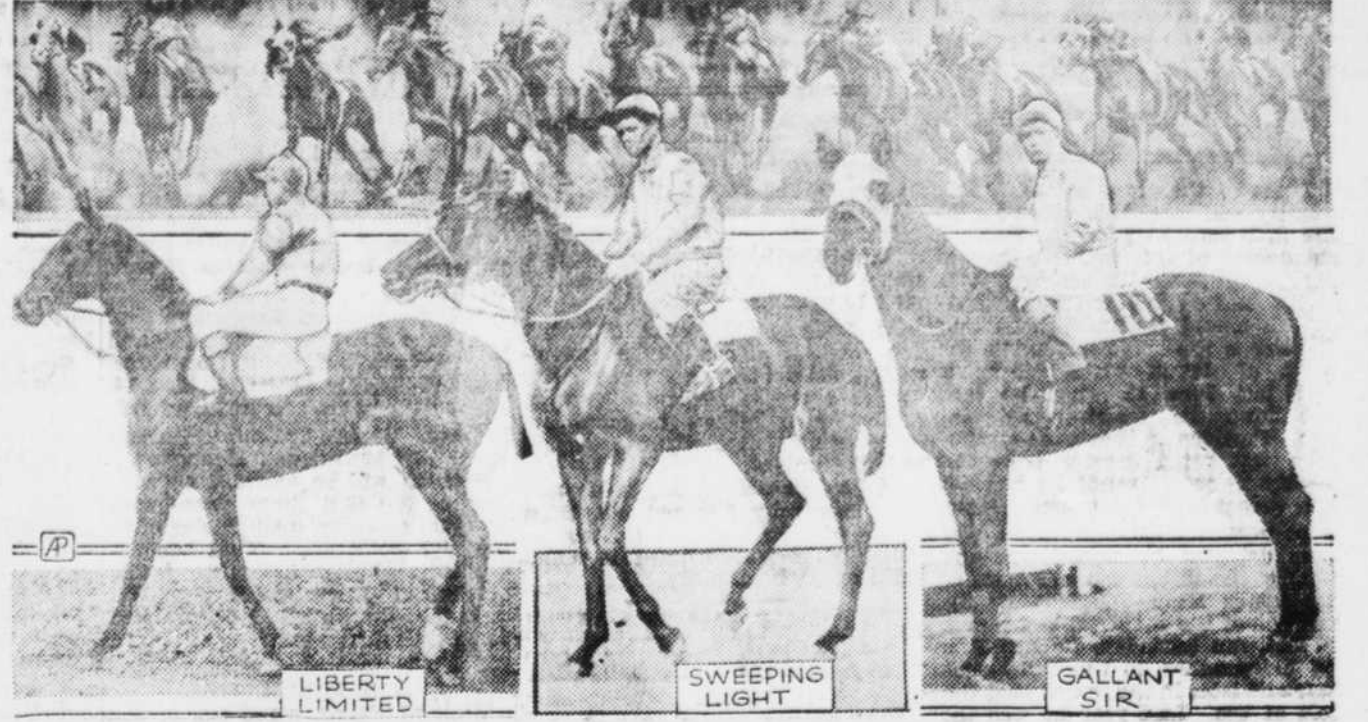
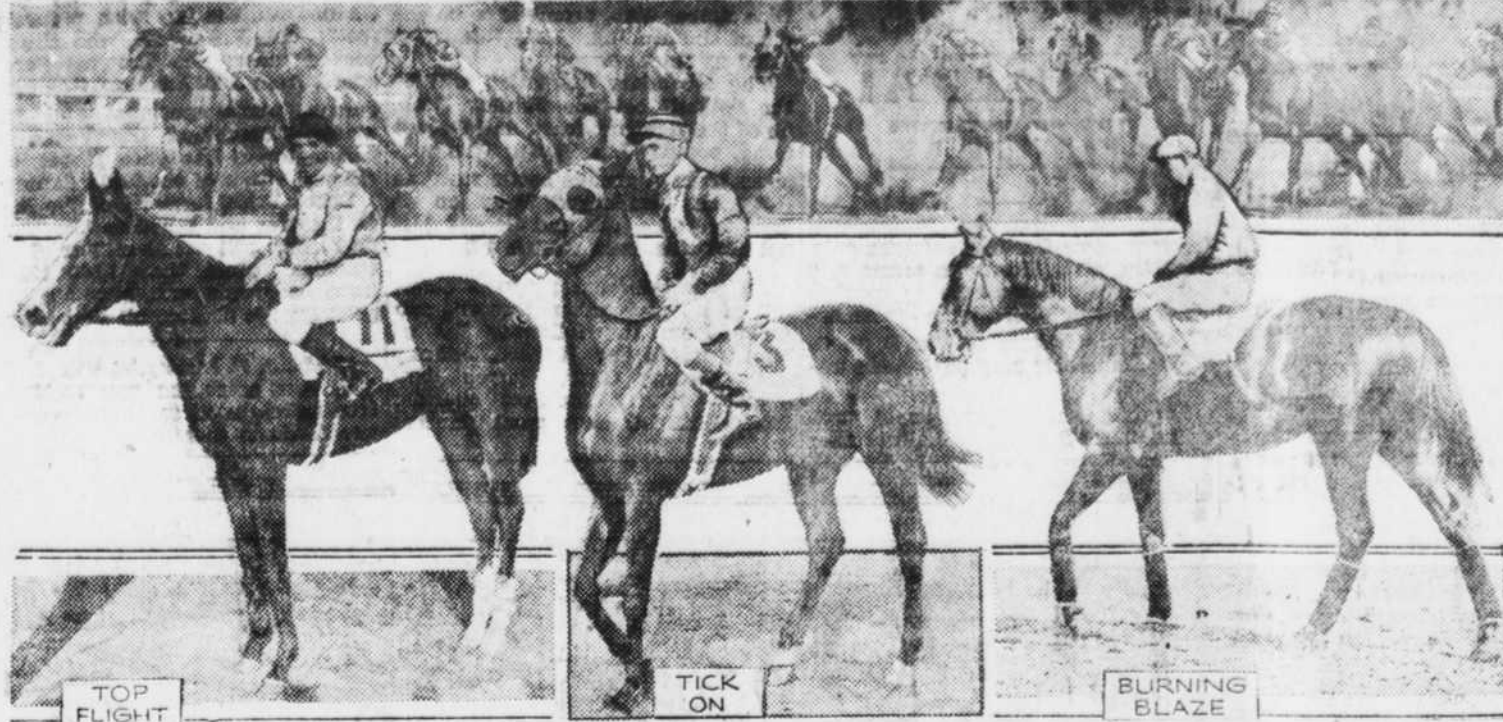


DERBY BLUEBLOODS :: :: Three-Year-Old Stars Ready For Churchill Downs Classic :: :: PARADE TO POST
