"I'll be the world's heavyweight champion within a year," he admitted as he planked his million-dollar chassis on a rubbing table at Stullman's gym. "As a matter of fact, I'm the best fighter in the world right now. Not too much of that alcohol on my back, Jerry." Jerry Buckley—dark, slender and watchful—who was sloshing the pungent fluid over the most perfect carcass in all pugilism, is Ernie's trainer and partner in the \$50,000 Schaaf-Buckley gymnasium at Boston. He came down with the 23-year-old boxer-financier to help him complete preparations for Friday's 10-rounder with Jack Gross, Philadelphia southpaw. Schaaf regards the Gross affair as "just another fight." He explained he was "out after the dough" and tried to agitate every two weeks, "anybody and everybody—nobody barred." Jerry, brother of Johnny Buckley, the manager of Schaaf and Jack Sharkey, adroitly encouraged this big-time talk, but every time the eager blond tried to edge up and discuss Park avenue, Mas-

seur Jerry plumped him down on the table and started kneading him. It seems that Park avenue talk is taboo in the Schaaf entourage. Ernie managed to admit between thumps that he was in love with a beautiful New York social registerite, but that's about as far as he got. "And when do you expect to get married?" asked the reporter. 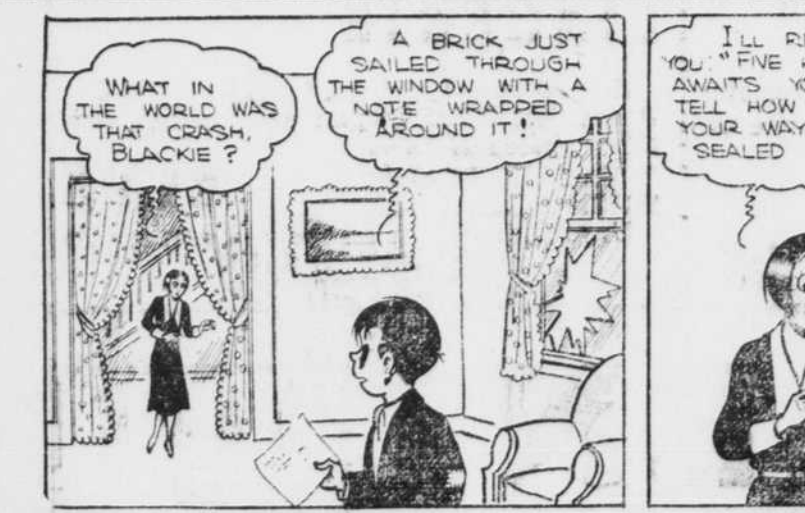

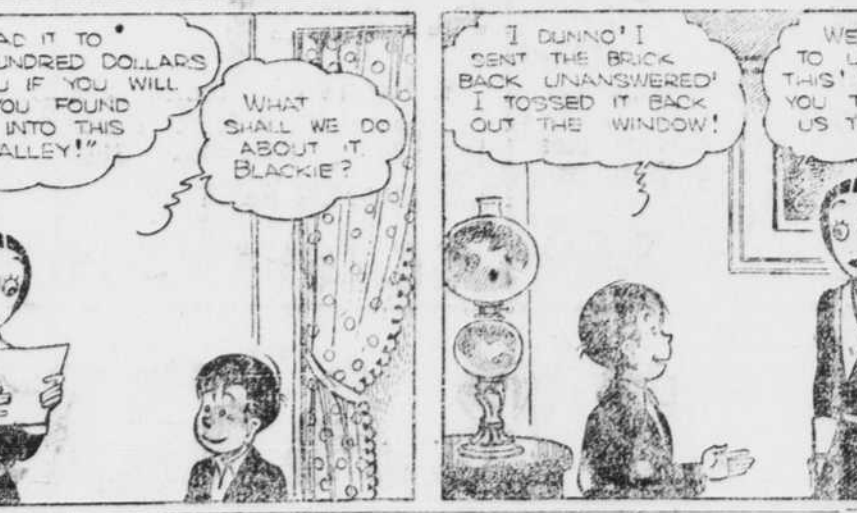

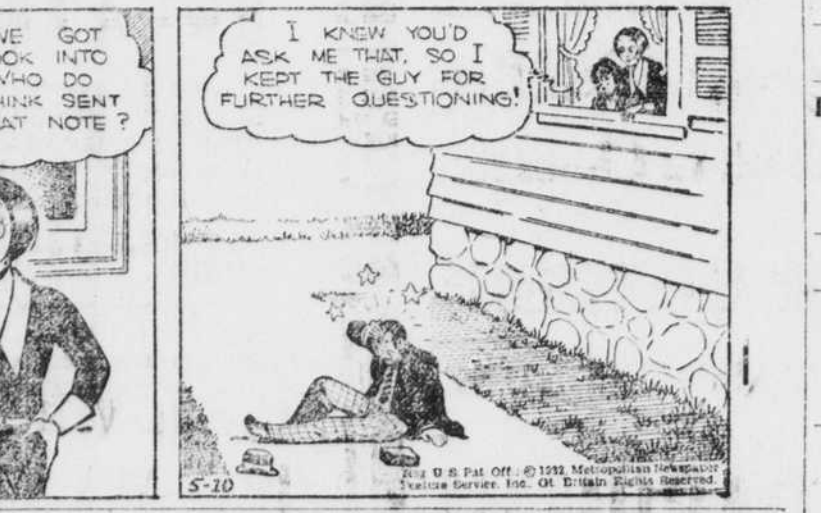
