TUESDAY IN CONGRESS

SENATE Consideration of tax bill again is halted as farm bloc fights for agricultural relief legislation.

Chairman Norbeck of the banking and currency committee indicated the Goldborough bill providing for restoration of commodity prices at the 1925 level would be favorably reported.

Passed without debate a resolution awarding the distinguished flying cross to Mrs. Amelia Earhart Putnam.

Judiciary committee favorably reported bill fixing penalties of 20 years in jail or fine of \$5,000 for sending ransom or kidnapping notes through the mails.

Confirmed the election of Rep. Coyle, Repn., Pa., in the contest action brought by Everett Kent, Democrat.

Ways and means committee adversely reported the Hancock bill to legalize dissemination of birth control literature.

Rep. Britten, Repn., Ill., advocated military control of Hawaii before territories committee.

Unanimously decided the election contest in the first congressional district of Oklahoma in favor of Rep. Disney, a Democrat.

SUNSET PAVILION OPENS SATURDAY WITH FREE DANCE

The Sunset dance pavilion, eight miles out on the Boulder highway and fifteen miles from Boulder City, will be the scene of an old-time dance, Saturday night, May 28.

Old time tunes and dreamy waltzes will be played by the orchestra. Admission is free for the opening under new ownership and management. Bill Woods, former cafe owner of Las Vegas, is the new lessee, and has secured the services of Dave "Svede" Anderson as manager.
