TUESDAY IN CONGRESS

SENATE President Hoover made his first appearance before congress and demanded action on the tax bill to balance the budget. Senator Costigan, Dem., Colo., introduced a bill calling for the immediate appropriation of \$75,000,000 to feed and house veterans who marched here to demand a bonus. Voted additional burden of \$70,000,000 on income tax payers after Secretary of the Treasury Mills had warned that an additional \$285,000,000 was needed to balance the budget.
