Miss June Page motored to Las Vegas Monday, where she spent the afternoon visiting friends and shopping, after which she went to the theatre.

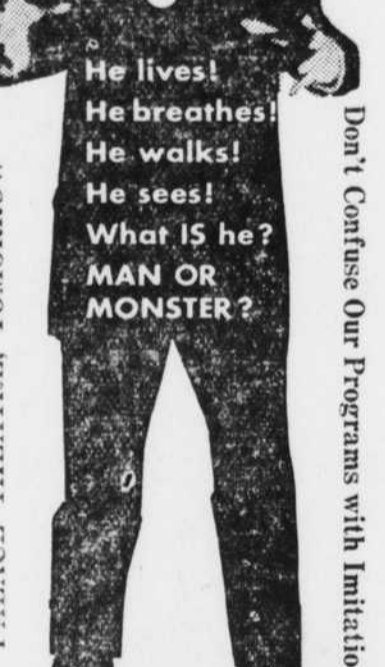
