NEW YORK, June 14 (UP)—The
American dollar struck a keynote of
quiet strength on Wall street today.

Stocks were almost as quiet as
they were in yesterday's extremely
dull session, but a whole lot stronger
because of the foreign exchange
development and the growing pros-
pects of an early adjournment of
congress.

After rising fractionally to more than
2 points, stocks then fell a little
profit-taking, but the underdone was
firm and declined from the highs
continued to small proportions. Clos-
ing prices were fractions to more
than a point higher as a rule.

High-priced stocks were the star
performers. These included American
Tobacco, Allied Chemical, East-
man Kodak and Westinghouse Elec-
trical which moved up 1 to 3 points.
Steel common bobbed up more than
a point to 27 1/4 early, but gave up
some of the gain later.

American Telephone led an up-
ward trend in utility stocks with a
2 point gain, later slipping to 85
3/8 to close 7-8 point higher.
