> "While I was ligutenant-governor, I offered a cash prize for the best design for a new state flag. At that time I pointed out that our state flag was very expensive to make because of the immense amount of detail and the many colors-forty in all. Many designs were submitted, and one selected. In 1929 the legislature created it as the 'official flag of the state of Nevada.'

WILLIAMS GIVES AN **OPTION ON MINE**

Ed Williams, who is the owner of an important mine in the Aquarius range, is reported to have optioned the property to Los Angeles people for a goodly sum of money and that miners are to be put to work on the mines at once. The property is about 60 miles east of Kingman, and have been operated to a considerable extent.

Some years ago a milling plant was erected on the mines and a goodly tonnage of ore was run through. Prior to that time an effort was made to recover the tungsten in the alluvium lying below the mines, but without success. It is possible that with the many machines lying idle around the placer fields of the country some may be had that will exact the fine tungsten some distance below the veins, where there appears to be a rich territory, something like that of Nederlands, Colorado.
