The choir of the Methodist church has started their Christmas cantata, the "Heavenly Child."

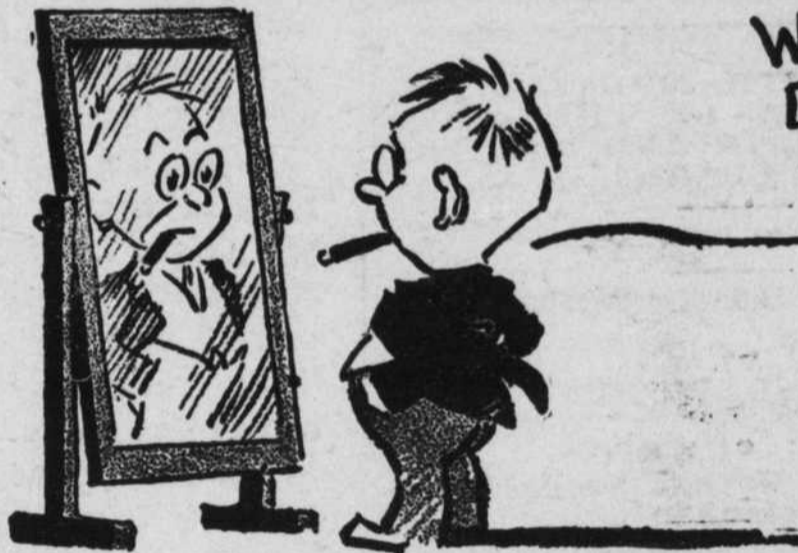
