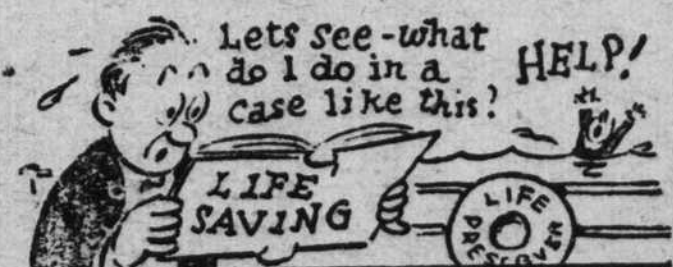
MRS. ARCHIEBALL AT HOME
