Add gelatin, sugar, and salt, and stir until gelatin is dissolved. Cool. Add cream and vanilla, Chill until cold and syrupy. Place in bowl of cracked ice or ice water and whip with rotary egg beater until fluffy and thick like whipped cream. Turn into individual molds. Chill only
