Notice is hereby given that on the 21st day of November, 1936, in accordance with Section 59, Chapter 59, of the Statutes of 1919, W. C. Morgan of Las Vegas, County of Clark, State of Nevada, made application to the State Engineer of Nevada for permission to appropriate 1-40th of a second foot of the public waters of the State of Nevada. Diversion is to be made from Point Spring at a point in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 11, T. 22 S., R. 58 E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point from which the N. W. corner of said section 11 bears N. 39 deg 24 min. W., 940 feet. Water will be conveyed by means of a pipe line to a trough located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion, and there used for watering 200 cattle and 23 horses from January 1st to December 31st of each year.
