Morgan of Las Vegas, County of Clark, State of Nevada, made application to the State Engineer of Nevada for permission to appropriate 1-40th of a second foot of the public waters of the State of Nevada. Diversion is to be made from Point Spring at a point in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 11, T. 22 S., R. 58 E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point from which the N. W. corner of said section 11 bears N. 39 deg 24 min. W., 940 feet. Water will be conveyed by means of a pipe line to a trough located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion, and there used for watering 200 cattle and 23 horses from January 1st to December 31st of each year.
