ORDINANCE NO. 223

An Ordinance authorizing the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, to borrow Sixteen Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-seven and 95/100 (\$16,597.95) Dollars, to cover certain unpaid assessments heretofore levied and confirmed by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas for the purpose of paying for the work of making improvements in the City of Las Vegas by grading for and the construction of oil bound gravel pavements, curbs and gutters on certain streets and portions of streets in the City of Las Vegas and particularly described in what is called "Las Vegas 1937 Improvement District No. 3," and to issue and sell the bonds of the City of Las Vegas therefor, said bonds to be known as "Las Vegas 1937 Improvement District No. 3 Bonds," and providing for the collection of the said unpaid assessments by dividing the same into ten (10) annual installments and placing said installments on the tax roll of Clark County and collecting the same in the same manner as state and county taxes are collected by law, and other matters relating thereto.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. That for the purpose of paying for the work or grading for and construction of oil bound gravel pavements, and curbs and gutters, on certain streets and portions of streets in the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, to-wit: Portions of the following named streets: Sixth Street, Seventh Street, Eighth Street, Ninth Street, Tenth Street, Eleventh Street, Linden Avenue, Mesquite Avenue, Stewart Street, Ogden Street, Carson Street, Bridger Street, Lewis Street, Clark Street, Bonneville Street, Garces Street, Charleston Boulevard, Division Street and Fifth Place the particular lots and parcels of land, and the persons to whom assessed being particularly described and set forth in City Ordinances Nos. 221 and 222 of the City of Las Vegas, for which special assessments have heretofore been levied and confirmed by the Board of City Commissioners and not paid in full by said owners of property on said streets heretofore named and in compliance with and by virtue and authority of a certain Act of the Legislature of State of Nevada approved March 13, 1909, entitled "An Act to authorize municipalities to issue bonds for the purpose of paying the cost of municipal improvements for which special assessments are levied" as amended, and in accordance with City Ordinance No. 221 of the City of Las Vegas, finally approved January 4, 1937, and City Ordinance No. 222 of the City of Las Vegas, finally approved the 4th day of January, 1937, and in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Las Vegas.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to issue in the name of the City of Las Vegas, ten (10) bonds of the denomination of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars, and nine (9) bonds of the denomination of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars each, and one (1) bond of the denomination of Six Hundred Fifty-four and 55/100 (\$654.55) Dollars, payable in equal annual periods of from one to ten years from January 1, 1937, each bearing interest at the rate of not to exceed seven (7%) per cent per annum, the said interest to be payable annually on the first day of January of each year, provided, the said bond in the sum of Six Hundred Fifty-four and 55/100 (\$654.55) Dollars shall be payable on the 1st day of January, 1937, and all of which said bonds shall be sold to the bidder making the best bid, but shall not be sold for less than par value and accrued interest.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas shall cause said bonds to be prepared and they shall be signed by the Mayor or Mayor pro tem, and the City Clerk, and counter-signed by the City Assessor, and authenticated by the seal of the City of Las Vegas. Coupons representing the several installments of interest to fall due thereon shall be attached to each bond so that they may be removed without injury to the same, numbered consecutively and bear the signature or facsimile signature of the Mayor or Mayor pro tem, and the counter-signature or facsimile

counter-signature of the City Assessor. Said bonds shall be dated January 1, 1937, and shall be sold at not less than their face or par value and accrued interest, and the proceeds thereof shall be placed in the General Fund of the City of Las Vegas to replace the money heretofore paid out of the said General Fund for making said improvements by reason of the non payment of certain special assessments by certain of the property owners in the time required by law. The said bonds shall be known as and called "Las Vegas 1937 Improvement District No. 3 Bonds."

Section 3. The amount remaining unpaid of the said special assessments for which these bonds are to be issued, as shown by the assessment roll on file in the office of the City Clerk and the City Assessor of the City of Las Vegas appears to be Sixteen Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-seven and 95/100 (\$16,597.95) Dollars, and the said bonds and the said annual installments due and to become due thereon for ten (10) annual periods commencing January 1, 1938, are, and shall be, a lien upon the lots and parcels of land hereinafter particularly described for the amounts of the assessments due thereon, together with interest at the rate of not to exceed seven (7%) per cent per annum from the first day of January, 1937, until said bonds are paid, the exact amount of interest on said bonds to be fixed and determined at the rate offered by the successful bidder on the said bonds, as provided by law, and the interest on said installments of the said unpaid assessments to be fixed by appropriate action of the said Board of City Commissioners at the same rate as the interest payable on said bonds.
