A STATEMENT TO VOTERS

It has come to our attention that the statement is being made that if certain candidates are elected to the city commission next Tuesday, the power rates will be increased.

We have no candidates in the field, and no interest in the election of city commissioners other than that of every citizen and taxpayer — good government; and we believe all candidates are well qualified.

We feel, however, that in fairness to all candidates and to the voters as well, that the following statement should be presented:

Rates for electricity are set by state regulatory bodies. Before these rates can be raised, due notice must be given, users granted the right to protest, and a public hearing held.

Your present electric rates, ranging from $3\frac{1}{2}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ c per kilowatt hour, are the lowest of any comparable city in the United States, and will remain in full force and effect no matter who may be elected city commissioner.
