# Closing Days For Enrollment

Major Paul B. Robinson, CMTC officer of Fort Douglas, announces that the enrollment compaign for the Citizens' Military Training Camp to be held at Fort Douglas, Utah, from July 1 to 30, 1937, is in its final week, and that young men between the ages of 17 and 25 who desire to enroll for the camp must submit their completed applications so as to reach the CMTC office, Fort Douglas, not later than the morning of June 3, 1937.

Major Robinson also announced that Staff Sergeant John Pool, on duty with the 30th Infantry at the post who was Sergeant Major of the encampment held last year, is again in charge of the Post CMTC of lice and will again be Sergeant Major of this year's camp.

The essential requirements for enrollment in the camp are that young men must be between the ages of 17 and 25, undergo and pass the required physical examination and furnish a certificate as to his moral character from a school teacher, clergyman or any other prominent and reputable citizen, who is personally acquainted with the candidate, and must be inoculated against typhoid fever and vaccinated against smallpox before they can be ordered to camp.
