

"Four States" To Convene In Ely

The Four-States Highway Association will hold its annual meeting in Ely on some date between September 15 and 30, it was reported by Secretary Oliver Goerman at Tuesday's meeting of Las Vegas Chamber of Commerce.

Since this highway is of great importance to Las Vegas the hope was expressed that there would be a large delegation from Las Vegas at the convention next September.

Secretary Goerman reported having letters from Miss Maud Frazier and Art Harrington, both of whom are putting forth good publicity for Las Vegas on their vacation travels.

On motion the courtesy of use of the Chamber of Commerce offices for answering inquiries, etc., as is now enjoyed by Western Air Express, was offered Transcontinental & Western Air upon the beginning of service here.

The secretary reported that many westbound travelers are frightened by reports given out in various localities east of the Rocky Mountains of the dangers of the desert country, but that generally such travelers who call at the Chamber of Commerce office state that conditions here are much pleasanter and

On motion of Mayor Arnett, Secretary Goerman was directed to notify the Union Pacific officials of the action taken by a group of eleven members of the Chamber Friday afternoon, July 9, in voting against recommending that the Union Pacific include a dining room in their new depot.

President reported that, with a committee, he had investigated the two complaints made of overcharges and unfair treatment of tourists by two certain auto camps, not members of the Chamber of Commerce.

"In the first case we investigated," he said, "we found the person who owned the camp at the time the complaint was made had sold out and left and that the camp now was in the hands of a woman who seemed to be all right."

"In the other case, our investigation convinced us that the complaint of unsanitary conditions was not well founded and that the charges complained of as unreasonable were in our opinion, very reasonable for the accommodations provided."

Bob Kaltenborn called attention to the efforts being made by the Junior Chamber of Commerce to

raise the money to entertain their district convention here next April without asking the business men to donate money.

"It will be necessary to entertain one thousand delegates at luncheon one day and a thousand at a dinner dance, and will cost the local Juniors considerable money.

"Among other things which the young men have planned is a picnic and Dutch lunch at Charleston Park next Sunday beginning at 1:00 p. m. The charge will be \$1.00 per person and the proceeds will help swell the convention entertainment fund," Mr. Kaltenborn said.

Entertainment features are being prepared.

Nevada Federal Income Producer

Although Nevada is smallest in population of any state in the United States, it is by no means the least important as a producer of revenue for the federal government.

All internal revenue collections reported by the government for the fiscal year of 1937 show Nevada exceeding, in its payments of internal revenue to the United States six other states and the Philippine Islands.

Following are the amounts of internal revenue credited to the smaller states:

Postoffice sales of documentary and potato stamps, \$4,102,744.63.

Totals of all such taxes for 1937 reached the vast sum of \$4,652,504,-106.39.
