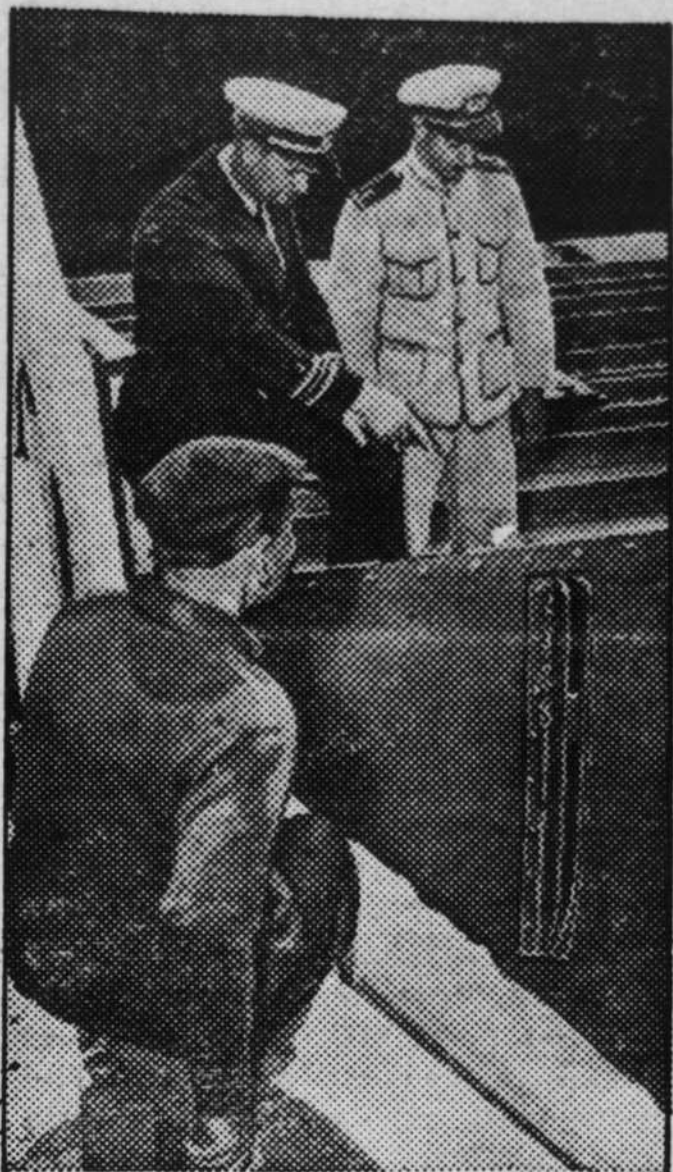

No interest will be charged on delinquent accounts if employers make their returns on or before August 10, it was said. The payments were originally due July 31.

Division officials said that the law is comparatively new and because field workers have only been recently sent out to aid employers in filling out the forms, the extension was deemed necessary.

The Nevada law prescribes that interest at the rate of one per cent a month shall be assessed all employers who fail to make their payments on the date contributions are due.

It was announced that interest will be charged employers who neg-

lect to file returns for the six-month period by August 10.
