NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed proposals will be received by the undersigned until and opened at 2:00 P. M., Wednesday, October 27, 1937, for the construction of a portion of the State Highway System in Clark County from a point on State Route 6, ¼ mile southwest of Glendale to a point on Route 7, 1.7 miles northwest, a length of 1.7

miles.

The minimum wage paid for labor on this contract shall be as follows: \$0.625 per hour for unskilled labor, \$0.70 per hour for intermediate grade labor, and \$1.00 per hour for skilled labor.

The Reemployment Office located at Las Vegas is the local agency designated to prepare the employment list for this contract.

Plans and specifications may be examined at the office of the undersigned; the County Clerk's Office at Las Vegas; the Highway Department Division Offices at Reno and Las Vegas; and the District Office of the Bureau of Public Roads, Federal Office Building, Civic Center, San Francisco, California. Plans, form of proposal, contract and specifications may be secured by prequalified bidders through the office of the undersigned. A deposit of ten dollars is required or each copy of the plans with proposal form, five dollars of which will be refunded upon return of the plans in good condition within fifteen days after the opening of bids. Bids

must be on the proposal form of the Highway Department and must be accompanied by a certified check in the amount of five percent of bid.
