#### WHAT THE SECURITY MARKET MEANS TO YOU

To the citizen who owns few or no securities the losses of billions that have recently occurred in the stock market may seem to be of no interest. But that is a short-sighted view, for the action of the security markets affects us all. The values represented by stocks and bonds constiute savings and surplus spending and borrowing power. When values sharply decline, that spending power is partially wiped out. People reduce their purchasing, productive employment lags, the production indexes of all types of industry drop.

This is not an argument for excessively high stock prices—it is possible that part of the decline in values was justified and marked a necessary correction. But it is unquestionably true that the government policy of excessively regu'ating security exchange operations and forbidding market operations, that in past times tended to take up the slack in thin markets, has proved an artificial depressive force that endangers all security investments and savings, and the welfare and progress of all industry.

The next congress will do the country a great service if it will revise security regulatory laws in the light of actualities ,to the end that dishonest manipulators are controlled and at the same time the spirit of the honest investor and security dealer is not broken or hog-tied by unnatural restraints.


