JUARTER MILLION DOLLARS

During the month of October there were shipped out of Kingman fifteen carloads of crude ore and twenty-nine carloads of concentrates to smelters. At the same time there were shipped about \$50,000 in bullion and \$57,000 in precipitates.

These figures are a slight decrease in crude ore and concentrate shipments of the month of September, possibly due to the falling in the prices of lead and zinc.

The gold shipments show that about the same production as in the preceeding months. Tungsten concentrate shipments from the Boriana mine continued.

The entire shipments would probably aggregate a quarter o a million dollars for the month.
