

Bank Says FHA Loans Available

Applications for Modernization Loans, under the recently revised Title I of the Federal Housing Act, are now being received by the First National Bank of Nevada, it was announced by President W. W. Hopper. Applications may be made through any branch of the bank. These loans are immediately

available for improvement of residential, business and income property in amounts up to \$10,000. The bank is also receiving applications for loans up to \$2,500 for new residential construction under the same title of the Housing Act, Hopper said. These loans are for construction of mountain cottages, lake cottages, small farm dwellings, and other residential property where a different form of loan is required from that available under the ordinary F.H.A. provisions. The Modernization loans are especially important. There is a great deal of prop-

erty which can be made to pay good dividends in convenience, comfort or actual cash through expenditure of very moderate sums to improve it. This is an opportunity for many property owners to enjoy better housing or to obtain an improved return from their business or income property. Hopper pointed out that with these loans available, it is not difficult to realize what modernization can do to change the exterior, existing rooms or make additions as well as painting and decorating.
