Sec. 18. Penalty. (a) Every person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a mis-demeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than five dollars (\$5) nor more than three hundred dollars (\$300), or by imprisonment in the City Jail for a period of not less than two (2) days, nor more than one hundred fifty (150) days, or by both such fine and imprison-

ment... (b) Every person, firm or corporation violating any of the provi-sions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a separate of-fense for each day or portion thereof during which such violation continues, and shall be punishable therefore as herein provided.
