## Desert Flowers Begin to Show

First signs of a beautiful wild-flower season in the Southland were apparent last week although not to an extent to warrant a special trip. Reports garnered from all sections by the touring bureau of the Automobile Club of Southern California

told of several acres of small blossom varieties just beginning to color fields south and east of Shafter in the Bakersfield district and of a few poppies and lupine appearing around the Edison oil fields. Worth-while displays were not expected until next week.

Advices from various district offices of the club also told of a few scattered flowers throughout the Coachella Valley southeast of Palm Springs. Another week should

bring them out in attractive array. A sprinkling of lupine and other buds has just begun to tint the Palos Verde hills south of Redondo Beach and above Hollywood Riviera, it was reported from that area.

Extensive, vivid showings through out the entire desert country are expected in the near future as a result of the widespread rains. In the Las Vegas-Boulder Dam area the display should be at its best during April and early May.

Following are the questions and the answers by percentages:

4. Do you believe the general policy of the administration toward business is conducive to orderly recovery and sustained prosperity?.....	11.49	88.51
5. Do you believe the militant labor movement has an important bearing on the current business slump? .....	92.41	7.59
6. Do you believe a person with ready money is justified in fearing to invest it in industrial securities? .....	84.91	15.09

The largest number of answers came from New York with 106, followed by California, 93; Texas, 81; Minnesota, 76; Missouri, 70.

The smallest number of answers came from Delaware and Vermont, with 2 each; Rhode Island, 3; Nevada, New Hampshire and South Carolina, each 5.
