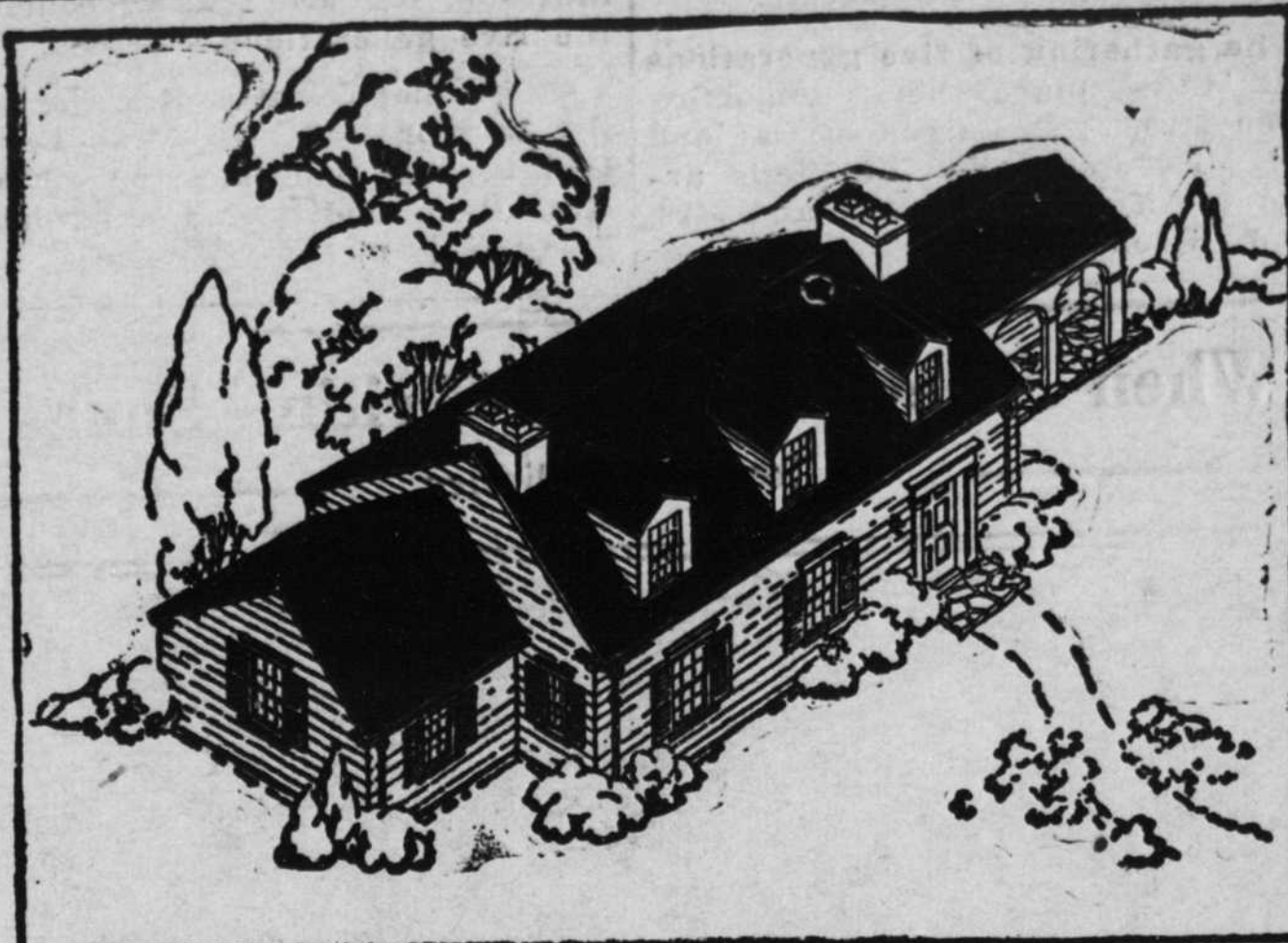
In short, Gary takes her as his bride, and then Claudette takes Gary "for a ride."
