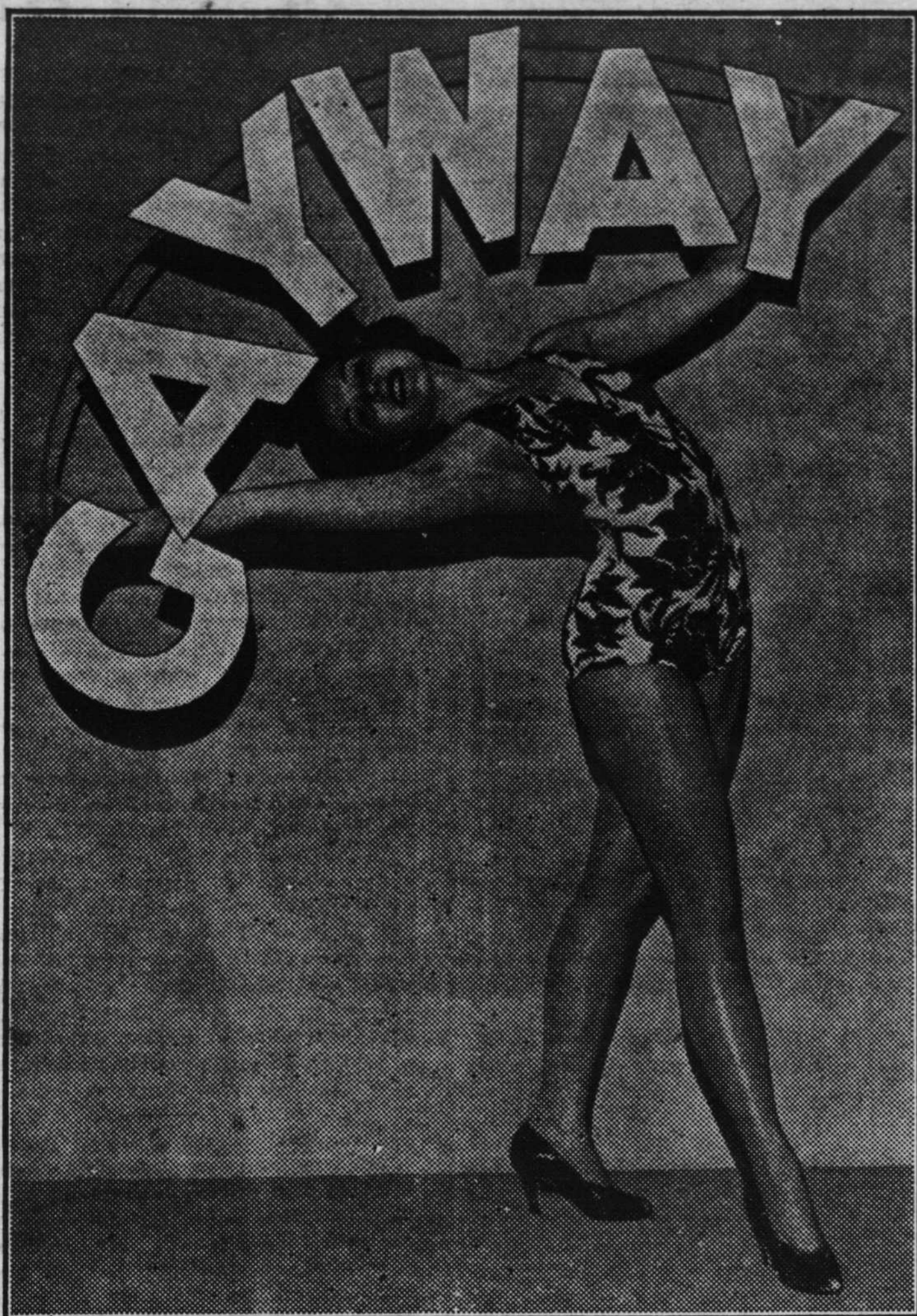


# Golden Gayway Planned in '39

## GREAT CARILLON BELLS TO RING FROM 400-FOOT TOWER

SAN FRANCISCO, April 28—Celestial music will peal forth from the Towers of the Sun, the magnificent spire on Treasure Island, during the 1939 Golden Gate International Exposition.

This "music of the skies" will originate in a great Carrillon—the gift of Dr. Nathaniel Coulson of San Francisco—to be installed in the 400-foot tower. At the conclusion of the West's World Fair the \$50,000 Carillon will be moved to a permanent home in the Grace Cathedral here.

The Carillon of forty-four bells is to be manufactured by Gillett and Johnston of Croyden, England, a firm which has fabricated Carrillons for more than 100 years.

"The largest Bell of the Carillon to be installed in the Tower of the Sun," said Cyril Johnston, managing director of Gillett and Johnston, will be the Bourdon. It weighs six tons. The note of this great bell is low G.

"The remainder of the Carillon will consist of three and a half chromatic octaves, rising from low C, which weighs two and a half tons. The total weight of the bells

will be twenty tons and with their frame and equipment the aggregate weight will be about thirty-four tons."

Johnson came to San Francisco from England to complete arrangements with the Exposition, and installation will be directed by a foreman sent here from England.

"The magnificent Tower of the Sun," Johnston explained, "provides an ideal site for the bells. The height will tend to improve the music, while the proximity of San Francisco Bay is a further advantage, for sound is carried further and mellowed near water."

## Gracie Turns Dean In Film

It is a rollicking farce showing what happens on the campus when the school nitwit inherits the university and puts her unusual ideas of education into effect.

The result is a mad a semester as Gracie, aided by a supporting cast which includes Edward Everett Horton, Florence George, Ben Blue, Betty Grable, Jackie Coogan and John Payne can make it. This enthusiast for "liberal education" promptly liquidates the faculty and installs her own pals in the places of the ousted professors. Hope becomes "Professor of Applied Romance," and immediately "applies" the romance to another madcap member of the faculty, Martha Raye. Gracie makes Ben Blue head of the physical education department and assumes the coveted post of "Dean of Men" herself.

As the head of the college, Gracie is ready to take in her stride not only the faculty but the board of trustees as well. When the Chief of them, Edward Everett Horton, a woman hating multi-millionaire, tries to spoil her game by taking the university out of her hands, she turns the tables on him and proves that she knows more about romance than she does about education. In a hilarious climax, she surrenders the college to him, while he surrenders his heart and his millions to her.

As Gracie's love interest, Horton plays his first romantic role in many pictures. The popular comic star was seen most recently as Claudette Colbert's father in "Bluebeards Eighth Wife." Sharing laugh honors with him is Gracie's director of physical education, Ben Blue, who won widespread applause for his performance as the rain-maker in "Artists and Models," which was brought to the screen by Raoul Walsh, director of "College Swing."

## Would Reduce Play Program
