

Children to Get Summer Camp In Lee's Canyon

The recreational camp in Lee's Canyon was built by the W.P.A. on the beautiful tract of land donated by Mr. and Mrs. J. T. McWilliams. It was built under the supervision of Claude J. Mackey and is admirably suited for the purpose for which it was intended by the generous donors of the land. A stay at this lovely spot should bring health and happiness to every child privileged to spend a time there.

The plan is to charge each child between the ages of 8 to 16 five dollars a week. The children desiring to attend the camp must be registered and must also pass a medical examination, to see that they are in the proper health to stand the altitude and camp activities. One dollar deposit is to be made at time of registration which will be refunded if found the child is unable to attend, if such notice is sent to the management one week before the date the child is registered for.

Ground is being prepared where parents who desire to accompany their children may camp.

The children will be under the care of trained recreational workers. There are six dormitories which will house 16 children each, a kitchen, dining hall and first aid room. The first camp will open June 6 and children will be received at stated periods until September. The snow is disappearing so that a trip to the Lee Canyon project would be an interesting outing for parents thinking of giving their children an outing.

With the fine camp grounds at Charleston, Deer Creek and Lee's Canyon and the splendid roads why not spend a little money for a tent and an inexpensive camping outfit and get the wife and children into the mountains for the summer. The father could commute in the old jalopy over the week end and have a whale of a good time.

Marmalade Bavarian Cream

1 package orange-flavored gelatin; 1 1/4 cups hot water; 1/4 teaspoon salt; 1/2 cup heavy cream; 1/2 cup orange marmalade.

Dissolve gelatin in hot water. Add salt. Chill until cold and syrupy. Fold in cream, whipped only until thick and shiny, but not stiff. Fold in marmalade. Chill until slightly thickened. Turn into mold. Chill until firm. Unmold. Garnish with whipped cream and additional orange marmalade. Serves 6.
