Marigolds Have Rich Velvety Colors



Marigold

Rich and velvety mahogany reds and browns, crimsons, yellows and orange are the colors which make marigolds a brilliant part of the landscape. Huge plants that grow to 4 feet_tall with blossoms like chrysanthemums, and tiny sparklers no bigger than a bachelor's button are all members of this favorite flower family; and they all bloom from midsummer through

Give them plenty of room to grow; 18 inches to 2 feet for the large ones is good. They like a fertile soil, but cannot stand over-feeding, which will result in spindly, rank growth of foliage at the expense of flowers and late blooming. Marigolds should spin up to a bud at once and then proceed to branch out and make good

Sow seed in the open ground only after all danger of frost is past. They can also be started indoors in a box when earlier bloom is wanted. Stake them to protect from high winds.

New marigolds of outstanding appearance are available this year. Among the desirable qualities these newest blooms possess is a delicate fragrance, which contrasts with the pungent odor of older types.
