4-H Clubs Will Camp In August

A new campground will welcome Nevada's 4-H Club boys and girls to their annual educational outing at Lake Tahoe this summer.

"Skyland," one of the finest mountain camps for youngsters in the west, has been obtained for the occasion, Thomas Buckman, assistant director for agriculture of the University of Nevada Agricultural Extension Service, anounced this week.

With better acilities available than for any other 4-H Club camp in the State's history, an educational outing of the very highest quality is in sight for this year, Buckman said.

Situated on a point extending into the lake near Zephyr Cove, "Skyland's" buildings are grouped about playfields, in the granite rocks, or in the groves of pine and fir trees.

Facing a large playground is the municipal main building, consisting of a combined assembly room and dining voiced by hall with huge fireplace, and the kitchen. Two separate groups of Air Races.

cabins, which will serve as the youngster's homes for the week, are scattered along the lake shore among the trees.

A baseball and general athletic field, a tennis court, a handball court, several sandy beaches, and other recreational facilities are available at "Skyland."

The camp is shut off from the highway and other lake resorts by heavy woods.

Beginning on August 1, the camp wil last throughout the week.

This year's encampment will be the fifteenth to have been held since Four-Aitch Club work was established in Nevada.

As is all 4-H Club work, the camp is in charge of the Agricultural Extension Service of the University of Nevada.

Several hundred youngsters from all parts of the state attend the annual encampments.

High praise for the site of the 1939 Golden Gate International Exposition on Treasure Island, and for the municipal airport, which will succeed the World's Fair there, was voiced by Cliff Henderson, noted flier and director of the National Air Races.
