ORDINANCE NO. 238 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGISTRATION OF BICY-CLES IN THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS AND PROVIDING PEN-ALTY FOR VIOLATION THERE-

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate or use a bicycle propelled wholly or in part by muscular power upon any of the streets, alleys or public high-ways of the City of Las Vegas, without first obtaining from the City Clerk a license therefor. Section 2. The City Clerk is here-

by authorized and directed to issue upon written application, biclcle licenses which shall be effective from the 1st day of June, 1988, to and including December 31, 1938, and thereafter said licenses shall be issued for the calendar year, commencing on the first day of January each of said calendar years, and ending on the thirty-first day of December of said calendar year. Said licenses when issued shall entitle the licensee to operate such bicycle for which said license has been issued, upon all the streets, alleys and public highways, exclusive of sidewalks thereof, in the clusive of sidewalks thereof, in the City of Las Vegas.

Section 3. The City of Las Vegas shall provide each year metallic license plates and seals, together with registration cards and isinglass holders therefor, said metal-Hc license plates and registration cards having numbers stamped thereon in numerical order, beginning with Number 1, and indicating the year for which the same are is-sued, and the letters LVBL stamped thereon; such metallic license plates shall be suitable for attachment upon the frames of bicycles, and it shall be the duty of the City Clerk to attach one such metallic license plate to the frame of each bicycle and to issue a corresponding registration card to the licensee upon the payment of the license fee herein provided for. Such metallic li-cense plate shall remain attached during the existence of such license. The City Clerk shall also keep a record of the date of issue of each license, to whom issued, and the number thereof.

Section 4. All persons engaged in the business of buying secondhand bicycles are hereby required to make monthly report to the Po-Hee Department, giving the name and address of the person from whom each bicycle is purchased, the description of each bicycle purchased, the frame number thereof, and the number of the metallic license plate found thereon, if any. All persons engaged in the business of selling new or second-hand bicy-cles are hereby required to make a monthly report to the Police De-partment, giving a list of all sales made by such dealers, which list shall include the name and address of each person to whom sold, the kind of bicycle sold, together with a description and frame number talic license plate attached there-to, if any.

Section 5. It shall be the duty of

every person who sells or transfers ownership of any bicycle, to report such sale or transfer by returning to the City Clerk the reg-istration card issued to such person as licensee thereof, together with the name and address of the person to whom said bicycle was sold or V. Section 6. It shall be unlawful for any person to wilfully or maliciously remove, destroy, mutilate or alter the number of any bicycle frame licensed pursuant to this or-

dinance. It shall also be unlawful for any person to remove, destroy, mutilate or alter any license plate, seal or registration card during the time in which such license plate, seal or registration card is operative. Provided, however, that nothing in this ordinance shall prohibit the Police Department from stamping Room thereof in the Courthouse numbers on the frames of bicycles at Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, on which no serial number can be on the 23rd day of May, 1938, at found, or on which said number is the hour of 9:30 o'clock A. Section 7. The annual license fee to be paid for each bicycle shall be \$1.00 and shall be paid in advance; and pursuant to Section 5 of this ordinance, such license may be transferred when the ownership of said bicycle is transferred, and a fee of \$.50 shall be paid for the registration of such transfer. All license fees collected under this ordinance shall be paid into the Gen-

dinance shall be paid into the General Fund of the City of Las Vegas.

Section 8. It shall be unlawful for any person to permit any bicycle to remain lying upon any sidewalk, or in any street or alley, or public grounds within the City of Las Vegas.

Section 9. Every person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.

be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be pun-ishable by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00), or by imprisonment in the City Jail for a period of not more than three (3) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment. In addition to the penalty hereinabove set forth, the Police Department of the City of Las Vegas or any of the members thereof may impound and retain possession of any bicycle operated in violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance, and retain pos-session of the same until the license

provided for herein is obtained by the owner of said bicycle. Section 10. The City Clerk shall furnish the Police Department with a record of the date of issue of each bicycle license, the name of the person to whom it was issued and the number thereof, within twenty-four (24) hours of the time of issuance thereof.

Section 11. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to have this ordi-

nance published in the Las Vegas Age, a weekly newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, for a period of two weeks, that is to say, once each week for a period of two weeks.
